Set within the home of Zoe and Benji Marshall and their son, The Marshall Project comprises a stunning ensuite bathroom with both the walls and floors rendered in Venetian plaster. To soft, seamless, create a allencompassing effect reminiscent of a day spa, Pastellone was used across the entirety of the ensuite. It is the finish of choice in minimal spaces. With a soft cream finish, the tactile nature and subtle variation of Pastellone work to add visual interest to neutral and minimal spaces, catching the light and imbuing the space with warmth.



In The Marshall Project, each element surroundings. complements its Α versatile and timeless base of Pastellone Venetian plaster acts as the ideal starting point for a chic and elegant bathroom. An oversized vanity as well as the dual 'his-and-her' sink setup and bathtub feature a fluted finish, which aids in promoting design cohesion across the space. Across the ensuite, tonal variation is employed to prevent the space from feeling flat; the palest pink on the vanity complements the wooden-look finish of the dual sinks. SOFT SEAMLESS SIMPLE ERRAY PROJECT
